

Supply list for Abstract Drawing

Quarter-

1. Medium sized newsprint pad (something around 24" x 19")
1. Multipurpose Drawing Pad (paper that can accommodate wet and dry materials)
1. package of colored construction paper

Several 6B-8B pencils

Charcoal and vine charcoal (the charcoal being the blackest, densest, velvety kind)

Ink (can be India, China or Sumi)

Container of white tempera paint

Container of black tempera paint (the cheap stuff for kids)

Multi-purpose glue.....Elmers, stick glue, the various kind in plastic jars etc.

Scissors

Brushes, assorted for wet material application, make sure you have at least a fine line brush, and medium sized brush, and a wider, house painting kind of brush, exact sizes not important.

Other materials will be discussed in class and can be added as the class progresses.
For the first class, all that we will need is a large newsprint pad and an assortment of charcoal and 6B-8B pencils.
