Apr 29 / Day 1: In studio

Mark-Making, Collage +Abstracts

Materials Needed: Sketchbook, Colored + Graphite pencils, Bristol paper

Provided: Construction paper, Printing paper + Crayons

Cover: Symmetry, asymmetry, harmony, thumbnails; Work from sketch to full-size

*Homework: Thumbnails / Sketchbook _ Create another abstract

May 6 / Day 2: In studio

Drawing + Still Life

Materials Needed: Sketchbook, Colored + graphite pencils, Bristol

Provided: Toys, dinosaurs, dolls, Tonal chart

Cover: Tonal, field depth, shading, + light – create still life with toys + a creative angle

*Homework: Thumbnails / Sketchbook _ Execute still life with objects of choice + cast light

May 20 / Day 3: In studio

Portraits

Materials Needed: Sketchbook, Colored + graphite pencils, Bristol paper

Provided: Canson Mi-Teintes Paper, Marker Paper

Cover: Blind gestural drawings; Draw profile + frontal portraits each other

*Homework: Thumbnails / Sketchbook _ Self-portrait with reflected image

May 27 / Day 4: In studio

Collages + Scale

Materials Needed: Sketchbook, Colored + Graphite pencils, Bristol paper

Provided: Magazines, glue sticks

Cover: Cropping, texture and scale; Create collaged landscapes

*Homework: Thumbnails / Sketchbook _ Create a collage at home from printed material

June 3 / Day 5: In field + studio

Acrylic Painting + Landscapes

Materials Needed: Sketchbook, pencils, 8"x10" Artist Canvas panel, 3 brushes

Provided: Acrylic paints, 5" x 7" artist panel

Cover: Work small from photo + use of thumbnails; Large panel outside on NMAL grounds

*Homework: Thumbnails / Sketchbook- Outside home / paint on 2nd Artist Canvas panel
