

Materials for Devoted to Drawing - Your Sketchbook Practice with Stacy Innerst

Sketchbook that opens like a book. Size isn't that important but something large enough to stretch out a bit and draw with more than just fingertips and wrist. Something you can comfortably carry anywhere.

Ink pens of various kinds; gel, felt-tip, micron, rollerball, ball point, nib pen (and bottle of waterproof ink)

Small brush for painting with ink and washes

Scissors and glue

Papers of various kinds for collaging, ie, graph, notebook, wrapping paper, parchment, magazines, other ephemera and so on and so on.

Watercolors or markers: Set of inexpensive watercolor cakes, markers, crayons, etc. We'll be using color on occasion but I leave the medium up to you.
