

Materials List for Exploring Color: Painting the Still Life with Peggy Nichols

Drawing Supplies

Vine charcoal

Kneaded eraser

Workable fixative

Drawing board, preferably wood

Push pins

Artist tape

Bamboo skewer (can find at grocery store.. but the thinnest you can find)

Sandpaper (for sharpening charcoal)

Box knife

Painting Supplies

Palette #1 ~ Day 1 & 2

Supports: Gesso prepared paper, canvas or wood panel. Size: two sizes / 12 x 12 inches and 12 x 9 inches.

Pigments: oil ~ Titanium White, Ultramarine Blue and Burnt Sienna

Brands suggestion: Williamsburg, Gamblin, Utrecht, Old Holland, Natural Pigments

Note: Do not buy student grade paint. Do not buy water mixable oil colors

Medium: Oleagel by Natural Pigments

Note: I will have this medium that you can buy from me for a considerable savings

Solvent: Gamsol

Note: buy small container. We will not be using much solvent. Good for cleaning brushes.

Disposable Palette or wooden palette

Brand suggestion: Gray Pad by New Wave or Grey Matters by Jack Richeson

Paletter knife:

Note: preferably with a long triangular shape with a narrow rounded tip

Brushes:

Type: Hog bristle Shape: Rounds, Filberts or Flats.. a combination.

Sizes; #2, #4, #6 & #8

Clean rags (old clean white cotton tee shirts work great) / or...

Paper Towels (VIVA or blue shop towels)

Roll of Saran Wrap (to cover palette)

Metal container for solvents / **Glass jar** with screw top lid

Palette #2 ~ Day 3 & 4 **Note:** for this palette we are only adding a few additional colors.

Support: Gesso prepared paper, canvas or wood panel

Size choice: 9 x 12, 11 x 14 or 12 x 16 inches

Pigments: oil ~ **Titanium White, Cobalt Blue, Cadmium Red Medium, Cadmium Yellow Medium and Ivory Black**

Brands suggestion: Williamsburg, Gamblin, Utrecht, Old Holland, Natural Pigments

Note: Do not buy student grade paint. Do not buy water mixable oil colors

Medium: Oleagel by Natural Pigments
