

## Relief Printing with two-color Linocut materials list:

From dickblick.com –

Speedball Lino Set No.1 Handle with 5 cutters 40203-1009 \$10.70

Speedball Soft rubber brayer 40104-1004 \$13.59 get two, or be prepared to wash one in between inking. Optional suggestion, buy a smaller roller for more detailed work.

Cranfield Safewash 150ml tube BLACK 40320-2024 \$20.50

Also, other color of your choice, or more...

Inking Plates – buy two, one for each color. Blick has options, choose what you like best

Blick Battleship grey linoleum UNMOUNTED. Mounted blocks will not be used in the press. 5 x 7, 6 x 8 or 8 x 10

Sharpie twin tip marker BLACK 21373-2020 \$ 2.16 or any thin black marker

India Ink 21101-2003 \$4.19

Paper: Buy paper larger than your lino plate

Blick carries Strathmore Printmaking Paper 8 x 10 and larger for an 8 x 10 plate

Paper Option – Artisan and Takach are local companies that sell printmaking paper. Arches textwove (Takach) is a really nice paper that you can watercolor on. Reeves BFK also.

If you plan on doing work at home, or want cheap paper to test print on Blick has Yasutomo rice paper sheets.

Other materials –

Painters tape

Tracing paper

Roll of paper towels \* important!!!

Metal spoon – optional, but handy if you want to do this at home later

Drawings or photos to work from

\*you may draw directly on the plate or transfer the image using chalk on the back and tracing over top

1 piece of black chalk/pastel

1 piece of white chalk/pastel for tracing

Pencil

Brush for india ink

Exacto knife or blade for cutting linoleum

Cutting mat – available at Micheals, Hobby Lobby etc...

If you really enjoy linocut it is worth investing in Flexcut or Pfeil tools. They are on Amazon and some local woodworker supply stores.
