

Perspective for Artists - Supply List

Some of the exercises will be performed in your **sketchbooks** where you may also take notes. You may use any brand that you are comfortable with, hardbound or coiled ring spine. **Paper should weigh approximately 60 lbs.** No pocket size books. **Exercises will require several sheets** (or pad) 18 x 24" Strathmore 300 (or facsimile weighing approximately 70 lbs.)

Work surface:

Any smooth work surface 18 x 24 or larger will do: drawing board, Epson board, Gator board, Masonite, etc. Drafting tape, painter's tape, or pushpins can be used to secure paper to the work surface.

Black ink pens:

Any black pens of Medium weight that you are comfortable using. (Flair, Faber, Pentel, etc.). I like using Pilot Precise V5 (fine) & V7 (regular).

Pencils & Erasers:

Three graphite pencils will be used: *HB, 2B, 6B* (Mechanical pencils optional). Sharpener. One blue or red colored pencil. Kneaded eraser.

Black Elastic Cord, One Paperclip, Two 2" Binder Clips:

One paperclip. Two- Two inch Binder Clips (pushpins for drafting boards) will be needed. Around two, or more yards of **Round Black Elastic Cord**. Flat cord will do in a pinch. Joann Fabrics (505) 0296-0275. Michaels (505) 299-4007. Hobby Lobby 292-9665.

Red Filter: BYO (will also be available for purchase)

Final Assignment:

For our final assignment, we will be transferring images onto paper, canvas, or board to be rendered in color. The student may **use their medium of choice**.

Oil: Canvas, gessoed panels, or canvas pads. 9x12, 11x14, or 12x16. Pigments and brushes artists choice. GAMSOL ONLY! NO MEDIUM! No TURPENTINE!

Watercolor: Arches, BFK Reeves, Waterloo pads, etc. Pigments and brushes artists choice

Pastel: Pastels and paper that you are accustomed to working with.

Instructor recommends- La Carte dark ground (Charcoal, Dark Gray, Earth)

Colored Pencil, Conté, Dry Media: artists choice.

Miscellaneous options:

Sanding pad, mat knife/X-acto, Glassine, viewfinder. hard eraser, eraser pencils, erasing shields, blenders, stumps, Tortillons, ...all are optional.
